



## An Informational User Guide for:

# Repeat Dialing

### **Call Back A Busy Number**

1. Press switch hook and listen for dial tone. Push \*66 from your touch tone phone (116 on a rotary phone).
2. If the line is not busy your call will be made. If it is busy you will get a recording saying so.
3. If the number you are calling becomes free in the next 30 minutes, your phone will ring in a different way. As soon as you answer the phone the call will be made for you without any need of redialing.

*While you wait to be connected, you can still make and receive calls as usual.*

### **Redialing The Last Call You Dialed**

1. Push \*66 from your touch tone phone(1166 on a rotary phone).
2. The number will dial automatically.

*If the number is not in an area serviced with Repeat Dialing, you will hear a recording advising you that the call cannot be made. Your Long Distance provider must also be equipped with Repeat Dialing technology to access long distance numbers outside your local service area.*

### **Cancel Repeat Dialing**

1. Depress \*86 on your touch tone phone (dial 1186 on a rotary phone).
2. You will get a recording to let you know that the request has been cancelled.

### **Important Features**

- Repeat Dialing only returns the calls that you made. To return incoming calls use Automatic Callback.
- Repeat Dialing returns the last call you made from that line, regardless of the time the call was made.
